Minutes of the 52nd ECM of UP Architects Association held on 21st April, 2007 at Hotel Clarks Shiraz, Agra

- 1. The two days conference was hosted by Agra Chapter of U.P. Architects Association. Chief guest Dr. Ashok Kumar, Divisional Commissioner, Agra, lighted the lamp and inaugurated the two days function.

amount at a time for new junior members, hence the provision for payment of fees should be made in installments. The house was not agree with the suggestion as it is difficult to maintain the accounts with present office set up.

- 7. Ar. Ajay Seth from Kanpur chapter raised the issue of life membership of Kanpur chapter which is not available on the records web site of UPAA. It was resolved by the house to form a committee of three persons consisting of Ar. Vineet Garg from Ghaziabad, Ar. Bharat Bhushan from NOIDA and AR. Ajay Seth from Kanpur to study the matter and give a report on the issue.
- 8. The issue of stay, by Hon'ble High Court of at Allahabad, against the renewal of license of Drafts Men was raised by Ar. Vineet Garg from Ghaziabad that Hon'ble Court may be approached for the revision of the order to make it applicable to entire U.P.
