## Minutes of 74<sup>th</sup> Executive Council Meeting of U.P.A.A.

### Held on 9<sup>th</sup> of December 2023

Minutes of 74<sup>th</sup> Executive Council Meeting of UPAA held on 9<sup>th</sup> of December 2023 at Saket Sports Club, Meerut U.P.

1. Ar. Ankur Bansal from Meerut Architects Association welcomed all the delegates and the Executive Body of UPAA and handed over the dais to the General Secretary UPAA. General Secretary called for lighting the lamp.

2. Meeting was called to order by President UPAA, Ar. Jagesh Kumar.

3. Self-introduction was given by all the members present.

4. Welcome speech was given by President UPAA.

5. Ar. Ankit Agarwal, General Secretary UPAA, read out the report on activities of UPAA

14. UPAA expected to all Chapters that all the members of the each and every local chapter should be the members of UPAA. The local chapters should do efforts for it.

**In any other matter-**

15. Ar. Pooja Saraswat from Ghaziabad informed about the new association of Ghaziabad and also informed that the President of that Association is blacklisted from Architects Association Ghaziabad.

16. Ar. Vivek Bhati from Greater Noida suggested to remove the recommendations of local chapter for new membership and cooling period of 365 days should be removed. At the point Ar. Rajiv Dwivedi replied that all the issues will be cleared in new Constitution.

17. Ar. Nirbhay Nath Dixit, Secretary Moradabad Architects Association, voluntarily proposed to host the next ECM in Moradabad by Moradabad Architects Association on which no one raised any objection. The proposal was accepted by UPAA and it was announced that the next ECM will be hosted by Moradabad Architects Association.

18. The Executive Committee has approved and decided to follow the findings made during discussion, as held above.

19. Vote of thanks was given by Ar. Ankur Bansal from Meerut Architects Association to all members present and expects that in future Executive Council will take extra ordinary efforts to achieve the targets so that we may be able to get UPAA on heights with the cooperation of all members of UPAA.
